The inscription price is for all of the team. It includes provisions, technical assistance, prizes for each participant, and a meal after the race.

Each participant must attest that he/she is covered by an individual insurance in case of an accident **and must have read the rules of the race which must be signed and sent with this inscription form.**

Article 1

The 6th edition of the Joelettes World Championship will take place on May 19th 2012 at Bourcefranc le Chapus (Charente-maritime) under the aegis of SYNAPSE 17.

Article 2

The course is approximately 10km on different types of ground. The start and finish of the course takes place at the « Place du Marché » at Bourcefranc le Chapus.

Article 3

• Team

The team consists of a runner that is transported and minimum 2 runners, the maximum is 4 runners. Parents consent or that of a legal representative is obligatory for minors.

Runner transported

The transported « runner » is a person who has a known mental or physical disability. He/she is not subject to requirements of age, his or her participation is conditional and the approval of the medical organization committee is necessary. During the race the wearing of a bicycle helmet is obligatory.

All transported runners not correctly equipped will be unable to join the race. His or her participation is subject to the presentation of a medical certificate stating that there is no condition against taking part in the race.

• Runners (team) :

The race is open to all runners licensed « FFA » and non licensed. It is expressly indicated that the runners participating in the competition are under their own responsibility. They cannot participate in this organized sportive event without:

*the presentation of a sportive license that states that a medical certificate has been given indicating that there is no condition against taking part in a sportive competition.

*for persons without a licence (of which this competition is open) a medical certificate or copy dating within a year of the date of the competition must be shown.

Article 4

There will be 3 classifications:

- Women's classification
- Men's classification
- Overall classification = the team that is the most rapid (excluding bonus)

The transported « runner » determines if the team is classified « men » or women ».

A bonus of 2 will be applied to each female runner (not counting the transported « runner ».)

Examples:

* Transported male runner

3 male runners
1 female runner-2'
= totale bonus 2'

* Transported « female runner »

2 male runners
2 female runners 2x2'
Totale bonus 4'

* Transported female « runner »

4 female runners 4x2'
Totale bonus 8'

* transported female « runner »
4 male runners
= bonus 0

Article 5

All engagement is personal, closed and definitive and in no circumstances can be subject to reimbursement. Inscription transfer is banned under any circumstances. All irresponsible persons who give their race number to a third party will be held responsible in case of an accident or if an accident is provoked by this action during the race. The organization accepts no responsibility in case of an accident due to this situation. The race number worn by the transported « runner » must be entirely visible throughout the race.

Article 6

The race numbers are to be obtained by showing an inscription receipt at the race between 8am. and 9.30am. on Saturday May 19th 2012. Proof of identity must be shown together with a medical certificate if not given beforehand. All affectation of race numbers is closed and definitive. **No race numbers will be sent by post, or given out after 9.30am. on May 19th 2012.** Once the team has been registered it cannot be modified without the agreement of the organizers. The organizers reserve the right to check up on the constitution of the teams at the start line and take the appropriate sanctions.

Article 7 - Official Jury

The jury is made up by the organizers. Their decision is final. The refreshment points are situated approximately at kilometre 3 and 7 and at the start line and finish line. The participants will have maximum 2 hours to run the race just to the finish line. The competitors must obey the rules of circulation - safety code. For security reasons a gap of 1m 50 must be maintained between each Joelette during the race. Courtesy and loyalty must be shown by each participant so that the race takes place in a happy atmosphere. The number of teams is limited to 100 and only the first 100 teams will be registered for the race.

Article 8 – General Services

The race commissioners will be in charge of road safety, medical service by an emergency point at the start and finish line and a mobile one situated approximately at km 7.

Article 9

The timing will be registered by the organizers. A team's performance can only be validated on the condition that all members of the team who passed the start line pass the finish line.

Article 10 - Insurance

Civil liability : according to the law the organizers have taken out an insurance that covers the consequences of their civil liability, those of their employees and of all the participants of the Joelettes World Championship. Proof can be shown to all participants who make this request.

Individual accident : participants must subscribe for a personal insurance with a sports federation those notably who are non-licensed.

Article 11

By way of his / her participation in the race each competitor authorizes expressly the organizers to use or to make or reproduce his name his image, his voice, and his sportive participation in the Joelettes World Championship with a direct exploitation in view or as derived from the course and this in the whole world by all known methods or unknown to this day, and for all the duration of protection currently offered at these direct exploitations or derived by the laws and regulations the judicial decisions and / or arbitrary of all countries, and international conventions either current or future, including extensions that could be made at this time.

Article 12

Bicycles, gear with wheels and /or motorized, other than Joelettes are formally banned on the course.

Article 13

The participation in the Joelettes World championship implies acceptance by each competitor to the rules which are held at the office of « Maître BOBANT, Huissier de Justice (Baillif) Rochefort 17 France. The competitors are held to an honorable engagement: to not anticipate the start and to cover the complete distance without straying from the pathway that is signposted. The team risks to be disqualified by the official jury if this occurs.
